


LANTAU YACHT CLUB

Set in the midst of this renowned, international residential community, LYC is a luxury leisure destination developed by Hong Kong Resort Company Limited.

The Club was founded in 1989, closing for a phased renovation in 2019 with plans to relaunch as a leading lifestyle yacht club and marina. The new marina is scheduled to open in the second half of 2020, with a brand-new design and state-of-the-art facilities that cater to the growing sailing and pleasure boating community in the region.




